Re: Construction Progress Update

White Rock Lake Patrons,

Thank you for your interest in the City of Dallas Water Utilities White Rock Lake (WRL) Dam Maintenance Project, a construction project that includes dam and spillway concrete repairs, slope stabilization improvements, and vegetation management within the footprint of the dam. The contractor mobilized equipment and resources to the area during the week of November 16, 2020 and is making progress on construction activities. The project has an anticipated construction completion date of Summer 2022, weather permitting.

The public is advised that starting the week of August 30th the contractor will be temporarily removing the water level control stop logs to lower the lake level to inspect the lower concrete shelf of the sloped revetment of the earthen dam. This area has been underwater this year since the beginning of the project and we now have a weather window to inspect this area and make necessary repairs. The lake lowering may be very slow depending on incoming creek flow. The level of the lake will be returned to normal pool level when the structural inspection and repair work is complete, and the stop logs are reinstalled.

Please be assured that the City is making every effort to minimize the disruption and inconvenience to White Rock Lake patrons. However, there may be some inconvenience to you as the construction work occurs. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.
