



Dear Valued Guests,

Thank you for your continued support of Cedar Crest Golf Course! The City of Dallas appreciates your patience and continued patronage of Cedar Crest Golf Course. After a successful transition from Winter to early Summer, the greens began to exhibit signs of extreme stress in the second week of June. The City of Dallas had water tests, soil tests, disease analysis and nematode assays performed by an independent lab and found poor water quality of the effluent water as the likely culprit. Chemical applications and a change to our water source were made and the grass and soil are responding nicely. We continue to test our water and conduct other analysis of our turf to remain vigilant in our actions to respond to poor turf conditions.

To obtain full coverage on every green as soon as possible, the City of Dallas has hired a contractor to remove the damaged areas and replace with new Tif Eagle sod. This process began on July 15<sup>th</sup>. Once the sod is installed, City staff will top dress, roll, and hand water while it begins to grow and fill in. The expectation is to have a playable surface as soon as the sod is installed and an exceptional putting surface within 2-3 weeks.
