City of Dallas Park and Recreation Department Code of Conduct – Participant/ Parents

Below are the expectations for all participants and parents who participate in the City of Dallas Youth Sports Program:

1. Parents/players are encouraged to provide positive support to both their team and opposing teams throughout the season.
2. Game time is forfeit time. Parents are responsible for ensuring players are on time for all games and practices.
3. Players/parents are responsible for maintaining equipment and uniforms for the duration of the season.
4. Sportsmanship is a priority. Participants are required to exhibit good sportsmanship throughout the program. Parents are encouraged to demonstrate good sportsmanship and set an example for their players and other spectators.
5. Physical abuse, verbal abuse and/or loud or intimidating behavior are strictly prohibited. Any violation of this rule by a player/parent will result in an immediate suspension and removal from the facility.
6. Parents are responsible for the behavior of any persons in their party. Verbal abuse and/or loud intimidating behavior by any spectator within the accompanying party is prohibited.

I agree to abide by the DPARD Code of Conduct. I understand that any violation of these terms may result in immediate removal from the facility/playing field and the possibility of suspension, forfeiture of the game and in some cases the inability of my child/team being allowed to participate in future sports seasons.
